## **Assistant Principals Message**

## Interrelate

St Therese's, in conjunction with Interrelate, is providing a Family Evening Program for our students in Years 4-6 to explore a range of pre-adolescent and adolescent issues; including sexuality and relationship education, designed specifically for this important time in your child's life.

There will be a Family Evening Program on **Wednesday 4 August 2021**. At this stage, this evening will take place in our school hall, however, should COVID restrictions be put in place, families will be notified as soon as possible. There will be two sessions on this evening:

- Session 1: 6:00pm "Where Did I Come From?" for Years 4-6
- Session 2: 7:15pm "Preparing for Puberty" for Years 5-6

The cost to attend ONE session is \$32 per family or for BOTH sessions \$37 per family. The age groups suggested are a guide from Interrelate, however some students go through puberty earlier or later than others. If you are unsure of which session to attend, speak to your child's teacher or Mrs Maretich. If you feel your child is not ready to attend either session that is fine also. The Interrelate Family Evening Program is organised every year, so you may choose to wait another year. At least one parent/guardian MUST attend the sessions with their child and remain with them throughout the session. If you would like to attend, please fill in the slip attached and return it to your child's teacher by **28 July 2021**.

Students in Year 6 will also participate in the "Moving Into The Teen Years" (MITTY) Program. This is part of the school curriculum, so compulsory for all students with a cost of \$39.00 per student. The MITTY Program will be conducted during the school day and will being in Week 5.

Information regarding Interrelate was sent as a Compass News Feed last term, and children in Years 4-6 received a note today outlining the program and the costs.

## **RE News**

**Faith Formation** – On the Monday just passed, whilst students enjoyed a pupil-free-day, the staff here at St Therese's enjoyed the opportunity to participate in a Professional Development day around the essential aspect of 'Faith Formation'. It cannot be underestimated how essential this aspect of our lives, not only as staff but for our students and you as parents/carers/grandparents, is to the authentic catholicity of our community. Without faith formation, without the deepening of our own personal and communal relationship with God, we stand to lose the essence of who we are as a Catholic school.

The formation we undertook on Monday was led by Professor Michael Dennin, a US-based scholar in the area of physics & astronomy and conducted via Zoom. The program for the day, "Faith, Reason and Miracles", was derived from Professor Dennin's book, *Divine Science: Finding reason at the heart of faith*, and centred around 3 major sections:
