

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
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Champion Fundraiser

Thank you so much for your 'adoption' of Miss Sunset!

Miss Sunset is a beautiful old local girl who was first encountered in 2010 as a young sub-adult after found sitting on a boat ramp at Sunset Beach, Soldiers Point. This was just the beginning of her long and varied rescue history as she insisted on hanging out in a very popular tourist spot with high traffic flow. A few years ago she suffered an injury to her left eye, leaving that eye blind with a distinctive opaque appearance.

Several unsuccessful attempts were made over the years to relocate her to a safer area, however the stubborn Miss Sunset had other ideas.

Sadly, this year, she was found up a tree suffering from a broken hip and although her hip has finished healing, it has healed out of proper alignment. She was also recently treated for Chlamydia.

She is now in a yard of her own and seems quite calm now that she is safe. We will be keeping a watchful eye on Miss Sunset's recovery. Thankfully she has regained some of her climbing ability and she has been moved into a beautiful and safe Sanctuary enclosure for her twilight years.

Your adoption of Miss Sunset is greatly appreciated and will help to pay for her care and the costs associated therewith. Adoptions such as yours could not be more appreciated.
