Principal's Message

Today our infants were treated to an incursion from the "snake tails' organisation and they were excited and fascinated by the animals. My thanks to Mr Smith for organising the last two days. My special thanks to all those who came and represented their cultural background and gave our students such a valuable experience.



Back playground






Professional Piano Lessons at School
