FEAST DAYS: St Mary of The Cross (Mary MacKillop) – As contemporary Catholics, it is important we remember and acknowledge the spiritual guidance of those who have gone before us. As such, we celebrate significant feast days throughout the year as we remember the lives of saints – those men and women who have walked the journey of faith before us, revealing to us the true transforming and healing power of a life lived by following the footsteps of Jesus Christ. The **8**th **August is the feast day of Mary MacKillop**, our first Australian Saint. 
Living Library Dress-Up Day


