Week 7 - Faith Community Week

This week is Faith Community Week at St Therese's, so there will be no homework. We encourage families to get out and about after school and enjoy the glorious weather we are enjoying. We will have **Wacky Wednesday** where children wear their school uniform, but add something "wacky" e.g. socks, hairstyles etc.

Child Protection Week

Next week, is National Child Protection Week, with the theme being "Where we start matters". During this week, we shine the light on child protection to ensure all our children are safe. We also start our child protection units in all grades, and the children will all read "My Underpants Rule". Encourage your child to tell you or a trusted adult anytime they feel unsafe. Back Playground

The back field will be closed all of Term 4, to re-lay the turf and fill all the uneven ground. In Term 4, children in Years 1-6 will have time each week at Alder Park to allow them to run and play soccer, etc. We will trial this in Weeks 9 and 10 this term. There may be days when the weather is too hot in Term 4, then children will stay at school. A roster of the days children will go to Alder Park will be published later in the term. As the children will be walking, Kindergarten will not go to Alder Park, due to the distance. The Kindergarten teachers are organising fun activities that till take place at school for Kindergarten children.

The official change over to the summer uniform is **Monday 4 September**, however, the weather can continue to be unpredictable until the end of Term 3. We ask parents to ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather each day, and are wearing their correct uniform each day – which may be a mix of winter and summer uniform.




