As a Catholic school, we do not celebrate Halloween, which occurs during this time.

#### **Class Lists**

The class teachers, learning support teachers and the leadership team continue to formulate class lists for 2024. We have had a few inquiries as to how teachers place children in classes, this is done by looking at academic, social, and emotional considerations. To address the social and emotional considerations, teachers ask children to complete a sociogram where children identify friends they would like to be in class with, based on current friendships, children they work with in flexible groups or in inquiry units. There are times where great friendships do not result in effective placement in the same classes, which teachers are aware of, as they have a deep understanding of your child/ren. Classes for 2024 give children an opportunity to make new connections, while also strengthening existing friendships. Children can sometimes be a bit worried about their new class and teacher, this is quite common and expected, and we will work together with you and your child, to ensure a smooth transition. Before the end of the year, the children will spend an afternoon with their new class and teacher/s.

Totem Pole Project & ATSI Family Day — Last Wednesday was a wonderful gathering of many of our Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander families including parents, grandparents and aunties as they listened to Mr Evis Heath talk about the totem pole project and the design of the first pole which will tell the local Awabakal story of Whibay-gamba (Nobby's headland) and of how Mowane, the kangaroo, came to hide there where he lives unto this day. Evis will begin painting during this week and, upon completion, will then share the story with our whole school community. Each subsequent totem pole will continue to reveal significant Awabakal stories and the deep spiritual and cultural messages they contain.
